ERROR

"Could not place all objects in the project. Verify that CAD has the correct search paths to text, line, and symbol information."

SOLUTION

1. Go to the AutoCAD preferences (to do this, right click on the AutoCAD command prompt, and select "Options.")
2. Click on the far left tab called "Files" and expand the "Support File Search Path" category.
3. Add the Eagle Point "images" folder to the paths (i.e., C:\Program Files\Eagle Point Software\EGPT\Images). This will fix the problem 90% of the time — AutoCAD just needs to know where to look for the Eagle Point blocks.
4. If that does not work, look at the AutoCAD command line(s) when the error occurs during the download, and there will be an error indicating what block could not be placed. Look at your Field Code Library in the Eagle Point Systems menu, and find the field code with that block...chances are that it is misspelled.
